


Summer Reading

Students will be reading **two books** this summer.

Book #1: Students will read a biography of their choice from the *Who is...* or **Who Was...** series (various authors)

 Students will use the book to complete the Biography Graphic Organizer worksheet which can be found on the school website. The worksheet should be completed for the first day of school.









Book #2: All students will read the book <u>Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing</u> by Judy Blume.

As they read, **students should take notes on each chapter**. Notes should include information about the main characters and events in each chapter.

Students will use their notes to answer questions and complete a writing assignment in class. The students will be expected to use examples from the book to support their answers. Students should include specific details and quotations from the book as they take their notes.

Parents are encouraged to read and discuss the novel with their child.

Although the students are only required to read two books, they can and should read much more this summer! Remember, the only way to become a better reader is to spend time reading!
